She was a Visiting Professor at the Escola Tècnica Superior d'Arquitectura de Barcelona-Master "Architecture, Art, Ephemeral Space" in 2006. And she was a Visiting Professor at the Department of Architectural History at the Escola Tècnica Superior d'Arquitectura de Barcelona in 2008.

She develops Cinema, Photography and Architecture. She created her own film production company in 2005. The current name of her company is Leve Productora.
